

From the Pastor...

Blessed Easter season to all! With the current COVID trends, we do feel a bit like resurrection is happening in our lives. More people are coming back to in-person worship (we've had a couple of Sundays of 50 or more in worship, seeing people we haven't seen in Sunday worship in a LONG time). It's a joy to celebrate the new normal of seeing people's faces in worship as we continue to expand our reach through our online community.

I want to give you a "heads up" about an important date coming in May. On May 15 we are having a vote on our Inclusion Statement, a vote we had scheduled for March 2020 before COVID shut us down. I hope you can be there that day. In the year leading up to our March 2020 vote we, as a congregation, worked hard to figure out together what sort of welcome we want to extend to our friends, family and community.

Here's a brief summary of all we worked through together in 2019 and early 2020:

In June 2019 we had Dave Nuchols (lay leader of the Minnesota Conference) come and preach and lead a congregational meeting. In September we had a potluck (remember those?!) and informational meeting including table discussions about our personal interactions with the LGBTQ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, and Questioning) community. For several weeks we had available copies of the lengthy Resolution 100 passed by the Minnesota Conference stating the scriptural and Wesleyan reasons why the United Methodists of Minnesota as a whole supported inclusion of all people.

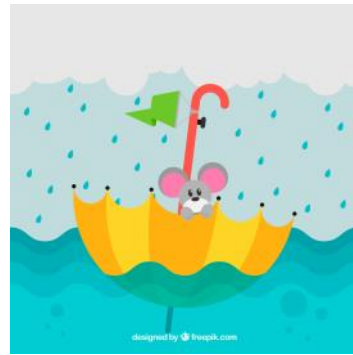
Meeting monthly starting in June of 2019, the Inclusion Team (Denny, Linda, Jane R., Deb H., Pastor Holly) developed a survey for the entire congregation. As a result of that January survey (which 56 of you filled out) we came up with this Inclusion statement: "All are welcome—people of all ages, ethnicities, abilities, sexual orientations, gender identities—to fully participate in all aspects of our hometown church with a global connection."

We hope you can come to worship in person on Sunday, May 15 and stay after worship for the written vote on this statement which offers us greater clarity on who we welcome to our hometown church. Our District Superintendent, Susan Nienaber, will lead our meeting following worship that morning.

As we move forward, let us continue to focus on our mission to reach all people with the love of Jesus Christ, and follow our mission to "Building Bridges to Christ's Love" in our community.

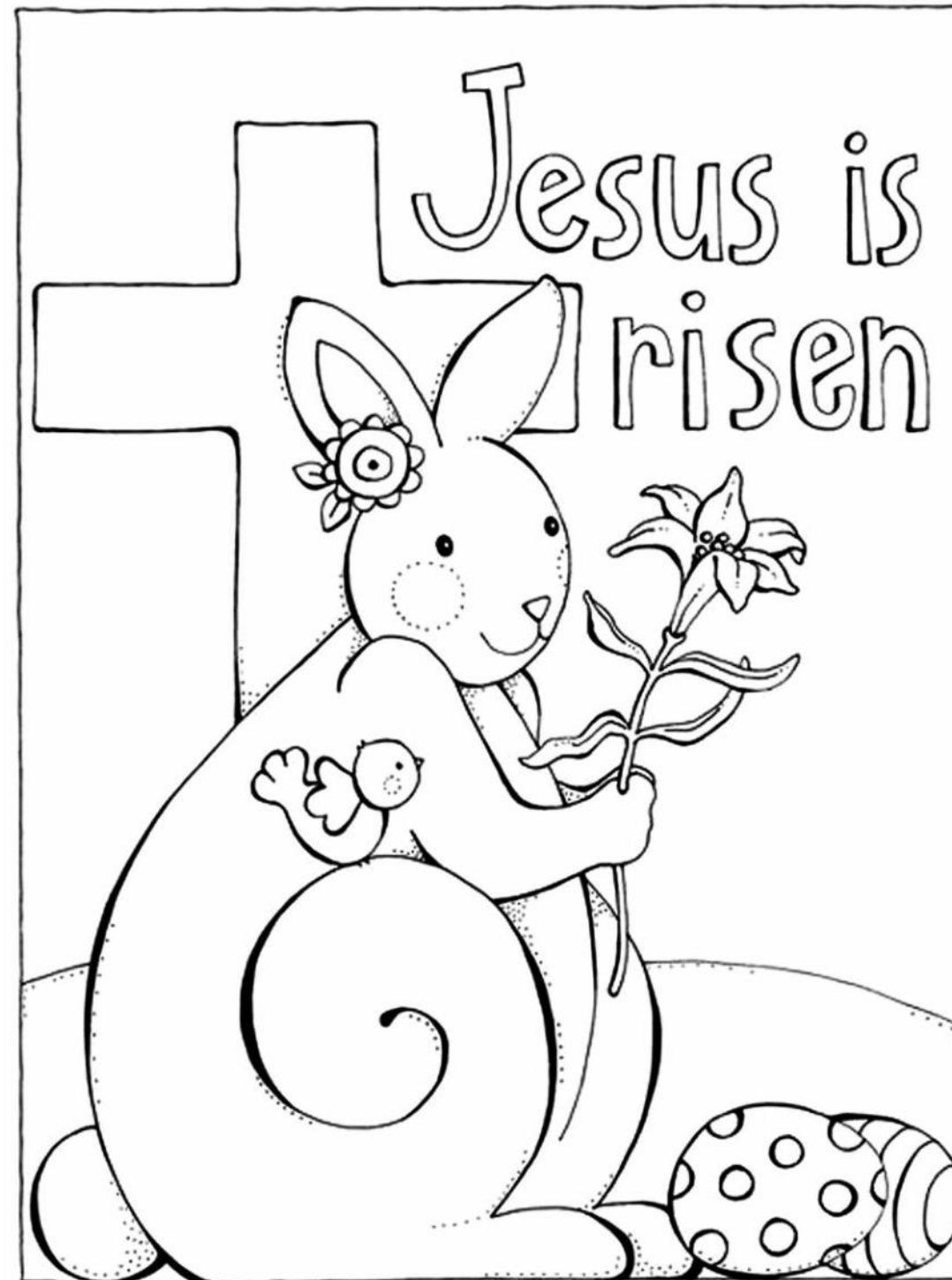
