# **Christmas Offering 2023**

The Christmas offering will be split between two charities this year: Strong Missions in Costa Rica and New Pathways shelter for families experiencing homelessness in Cambridge. Dave Freemore and Deb Hoffmeister will not be traveling to Costa Rica this January as they would like to try a new mission experience but the Costa Rica ministry will still welcome our donation! They continue to work on projects making homes livable, repairing churches and schools, and building playgrounds as well as support for food programs, building gardens, and hosting activity programs for youth and children which help in their education and keep them out of gangs.

New Pathways family shelter: we have been hosting families experiencing homelessness for at least 10 years here in our building for New Pathways. We know the pain each family feels every Sunday when they pack their belongings and head to yet ANOTHER church for the coming week. Thankfully, the shelter is now on

the brink of constructing their own facility in Cambridge which will house eight families at a time until they find stable housing of their own. No more moving every Sunday! Each apartment will include a living area, a bedroom (or two), a small kitchenette, and a bathroom (see building plans in the narthex). The new facility will be staffed 24 hours per day, 7 days per week plus there will be staff to counsel and work with the families as needed.

Both of these ministries are in need of our help. What a joy it is to be able to share what we have with others who need us so very much! Please be generous as you make your Christmas offering this year. Pastor Holly is encouraging us to consider donating to the Christmas offering an amount equal to what we spend on Christmas gifts this year. Last year we were able to donate \$3345!
