Course Synopsis:

In this course we will attempt to explore these questions by breaking down a worship service over the course of nine weeks, with each week focusing on a different practice. Through mini-lectures and group discussion, we will look at these practices from a practical, historical, and, most crucially, a theological perspective. As we explore this material together, we will be able to deepen our appreciation of worship and be more intentional about the practice of our shared faith.
